4 inch by 8 inch bricks cost **\$50.00** each.

8 inch by 8 inch bricks cost **\$100.00** each.

You can purchase one or several engraved bricks. Engravings can be purchased in your name or the name of a family member, pet, or friend; in celebration of a birth, baptism, confirmation, graduation, wedding, or anniversary; in honor of a soldier or veteran; or in memory of someone you love. Honor a unique milestone, commemorate a special occasion, provide an inspiring quote, remember a loved one, or purchase one as a gift; the possibilities are endless. You have the option to add images to your brick to enhance its appearance.

This is not a fundraiser and your purchase for this project is not a donation. **ALL** purchases are to personalize the bricks, to appropriately develop the paver garden, and for any necessary maintenance.
